Scope

Arrangements

ODGroup aims to achieve the above through our Business Management System (BMS) that has been certified to ISO 45001:2018 standard. We will reach these aims by:

- Identifying, managing and communicating risks in order to reduce the impact of our activities
- Identifying laws and regulations that are applicable to our work activities
- Ensuring our employees have the correct skills and knowledge to work safely, prevent injury and ill-health.
- Setting yearly targets to drive continual improvement
- Developing an effective health and safety culture

Responsibilities

- It is the responsibility of the Managing Director to review, approve and achieve this policy's aims.
- It is the responsibility of Senior Management to ensure our objectives are achieved.
- It is the responsibility of the Quality and Compliance Manager to ensure the processes needed for the Health, Safety and Environmental Management System are established, implemented, maintained and reviewed as well as report, on the performance and any improvements needed.
- It is the responsibility of the Sustainability & Well-being Manager to establish, implement, monitor and review strategies and processes which align with the environmental aims of this policy to reduce the environmental impact of the work we carry out.
- It is the responsibility of the Health and Safety Consultant to monitor the safety and environmental performance on site and provide guidance where necessary.
- It is the responsibility of all Managers to implement and enforce the processes and procedures defined in the Management System.
- It is the responsibility of all employees to comply with this policy and company procedures.
